States have indicated that it would be useful to track member participation at state table activities, and we couldn't agree more. RE-AMP staff are already in the practice of tracking participation across working groups and caucuses to make sure we're providing the support members need and want and to make sure organizations meet the [expectations](#) of membership. For example, Full Member Organizations can satisfy the expectations of membership by participating in a working group, caucus, OR state table. As such, RE-AMP staff will rely on participation data collected at state tables to assess our members organizations' standing within the Network, as well as overall Network health.

We hope the new tracker will make it easy for you to collect participation data. Here's what you need to know to use it:

The "Member Organizations Overview" sheet includes the current RE-AMP membership list, as well as a membership level and primary contact information for each organization. You can sort column "D" alphabetically to easily identify the organizations based in your state. RE-AMP staff will update this sheet on an ongoing basis. (This information is also available to all members on the [Current Member List](#) page on the Commons.)

Each state table has its own unique sheet in the participation tracker labeled with its state name (e.g., "Iowa", "Illinois"). See the screenshot below.
